Fall has arrived and with it is a renewed effort to help keep Choya Bay clean!

Here are TWO PROJECTS:

Transform our cans into art

The Vecinos de la Choya is purchasing 10 cans to be placed at beach accesses. Unfortunately many of the receptacles previously purchased by the Vecinos for Zofemat for that purpose disappeared. To prevent this from reoccurring it was suggested that the cans should be painted. Help is needed to get this accomplished.

Let's turn this into a public art project. Many communities have promoted public art by providing participants with a plain animal to be decorated and then placed them in public spaces. There are decorated horses, pigs, birds, dogs, (see photos) why not cans??

Call out to all full and part time Vecinos: We need 10 participants (or groups) to agree to decorate one can. They can be as fancy or simple as you choose. A Zofemat sticker to provide identification and ownership of the cans will be included. The goal is to make these cans look different from other cans and promote a cleaner Choya so almost anything goes... (no profanity)

Once they are decorated they will be secured with a cable and set up at posts to prevent them from tipping over.

Today thru October 31: Identify participants, coordinate delivery of can

November 30: All decorated cans completed and ready for setup in the community.

December 2024: Cans set up in community, photographed and are highlighted with a contest
