What IS the Vecinos Service Organization?

It is a nonprofit Civil Association, registered with the city of Puerto Peñasco, to provide essential services not provided to property owners by the city, including: Road Maintenance, Street Signage, Police Substation, Water Delivery, Beach Sanitary Facilities and more.

In addition to the services named above, the organization maintains the park, community center, lending library and manages and reports on the financial activity of the Association.

This Service Organization is led by a volunteer Board of Directors who are elected by the membership. They work in conjunction with city offices and agencies, and report monthly on their activities.

The Vecinos Service Organization is NOT:

A body that tells you to pull your weeds or what color you can paint your house, or one that enforces zoning and building regulations. That lies with the Peñasco city government.

What's in it for me?

The services enhance property values, quality of life, health and safety. Plus, you are part of a community that works together for the benefit of all.

What does it cost?

The dues are \$150 a year. This is 1/10 what similar areas pay. Members pay trash service separately at the rate set by the City for once-a-week service.

Where does the money go?

The graphs below show the distribution of member funds, allocated according to the annual budget which is approved by the membership.

Who is responsible?

Property owners are responsible for the integrity of the community by being active participants in the organization. A volunteer Board of Directors guides the maintenance and enhancement of the community.

What are my rights as a member?

You have a voice at the monthly meetings. You can vote in the annual election and serve on a committee. You can run for elected office on the Board of Directors. You can enjoy the benefit of services provided by the organization and take pride in helping to create a safe and vibrant community.

FEE SCHEDULE:

Single family residence (house, mobile, garage with living quarters) = 1 membership

Adjacent Vacant Lot no utilities = No additional fee

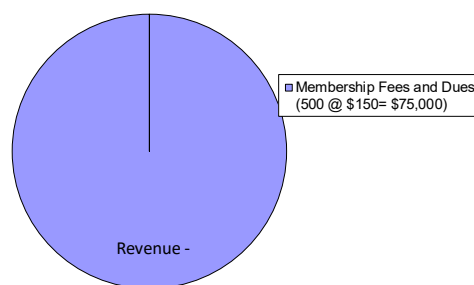
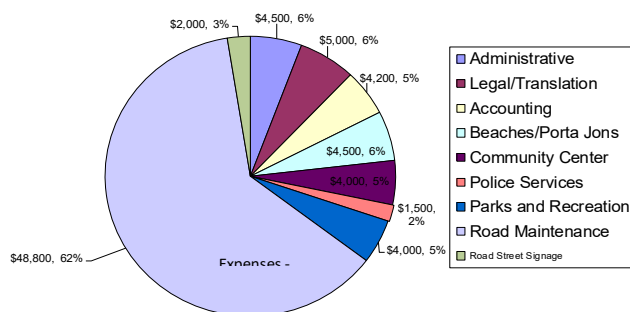
Vacant Lot, no meter, no facilities = 1 membership

Single location business = 1 membership

The Charity has very little overhead, so nearly 100% of the funds donated go directly to Cholleros in need.

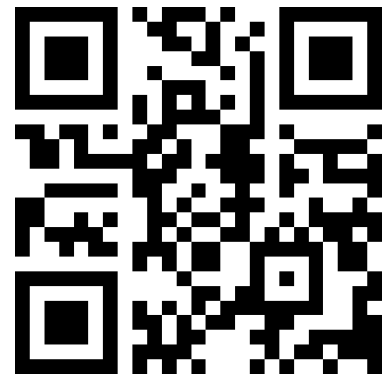
