

Proposed Revisions to the Constitution

Article 32 c

Original Wording: The result of the vote will be immediately announced to the Assembly, so that the Board of Directors or the Director General, if applicable, and the elected Special Commissions, take possession of their positions.

Proposed Revision: The result of the vote will be immediately announced to the Assembly, so that the Board of Directors or the Director General, if applicable, and the elected Special Commissions, take possession of their positions at the start of the next fiscal year, giving new Board members six weeks of transitional orientation with their predecessor.

Article 34 c

Original Wording: The Board of Directors ... in addition to the powers referred to in the previous clause, it will have the following: ...

c. Inform of the activities to any associate who requests it.

Proposed Revision: The Board of Directors ... in addition to the powers referred to in the previous clause, it will have the following: ...

c. Inform of the activities to any associate who requests it with two weeks' notice.

Additions to the Constitution:

1. Four members of the Board will constitute a quorum for meetings and voting.
2. Attendance by electronic medium qualifies as attendance in person.
3. Any board member who misses three or more regularly scheduled meetings can be removed from the Board by a simple majority vote of the Board.
